If you are applying for Philosophy and Linguistics (PPL); Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) or Psychology and Philosophy (PPL), you need to take the Thinking Skills Assessment (TSA) Oxford. (Note that, depending on the selected course, an additional admissions test may need to be taken, e.g. MLAT.)

If you are applying for any Philosophy and Modern Languages course, you need to take the relevant parts of the Modern Languages Admissions Tests (MLAT).
